50TH ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION: Come and join the celebration! The Los Angeles Chinatown Central Plaza would like to invite the founders, merchants, senior citizens, young people, tourists and guests to the 50th Anniversary Celebration of the Los Angeles Chinatown Central Plaza. Founded on June 25, 1938, Chinatown is planning a gala festival to celebrate its Golden Anniversary. Members of the Chinese community, including the Chamber of Commerce, Chinese Historical Society of Southern California (CHSSC), Castelar Street School, the family associations, Merchants Association, Chinatown Corporation and others, are working together to make this once in a lifetime event something that will be remembered for years to come.

The 72-page special souvenir booklet titled, "The Golden Years of Los Angeles Chinatown", produced by CHSSC for The Los Angeles Chinatown Corporation, will be available for sale on June 25. Cost is \$3. Featured in the souvenir booklet will be six historic articles, many historic photos — never before seen — from the old families — a collector's item. The booklet will highlight the grand opening of Chinatown 50 years ago as well as special moments throughout the past.
