The Chinese Historical Society of Southern California (CHSSC) seeks a motivated individual to provide full time office assistance under the supervision of the president or his/her designee. Candidate shall support the daily operations of the Society. Duties shall include most aspects of clerical office operations. Candidate may schedule and coordinate walking tours. 
